2011 Session Update

NDAR Leadership has issued a challenge to all committees for 100% participation in RPAC. The focus is that ALL members of every committee give at least the \$30 per member goal. Leaders in the Association need to set the example and that will in turn help achieve the state goal of 75% participation overall.

Claus Lembke, Government Affairs Director, reviewed bills that NDAR is involved in. On SB2187, the Appraisal bill, each section was reviewed. It was stated that in the meeting the previous week it was changed to have either a builder or a REALTOR® sit on the Appraisal Board.
