

On October 23, the "Rookie Course" will be held in conjunction with the NDAR Fall Meetings and REALTOR® Summit. It is open to any new REALTOR® members since 2005 and is approved for three hours of CE by the ND Real Estate Commission. The course is free to these members and will cover agency, professionalism (to include liability issues, appearance, proper notifications and safety) and what it means to be a REALTOR®. REALTOR® Summit

Please plan to join NDAR at the REALTOR® Summit on October 23-24. The program will start off with lunch and a speaker on "team work" to be followed by a session on parliamentary procedures and how to run a meeting. A Panel of Past Presidents will then speak on their leadership experiences and the day will end with two technology sessions focusing on website design, Search Engine Optimism (SEO), posting photos and videos and technology tips. Wednesday you will hear from three NAR Leaders, EVP Dale Stanton, Senior Vice President of Human Resources, Doug Hinderer and Senior Vice President of Communications, Frank Sibley. The trio will give updates on NAR's Strategic Plan, Second Century Initiatives, Volunteer/Staff Working Relations and the Public Awareness Campaign. NDAR Legal Council will give a summary of the most often asked questions from the Legal Hotline followed up by a working lunch with a panel of Real Estate Commissioners. Re-up Needed for Do Not Call List

Phone numbers will begin to drop off the national Do Not Call List. The Federal Trade Commission, which oversees the lists, says there is a simple fix. But some lawmakers think it is a hassle to expect people to reregister.

Expiration Date: Numbers placed on the registry, begun in June 2003, are valid for five years. For the millions of people who signed onto the list in its early days, their numbers will automatically drop off beginning in June if they do not enroll again.

Click or call to Re-enlist: People can register their home and cell phone numbers or file complaints at www.donotcall.gov or by calling 1-888-382-1222. The registry prohibits telemarketers from calling phone numbers on the list.

The Exceptions: Organizations engaged in charitable, political or survey work are exempt. Companies that have an established business relationship with a customer also may call for up to 18 months after the last purchase, payment or delivery.

Technology Tip

How To Add a Contact to Your Address Book in Outlook 2000

Outlook 2000 does not automatically add addresses to your contact list. When you receive an e-mail from someone who you want to add to your Contact List, do the following:

- 1. Open the e-mail message
- 2. Right-click on the e-mail address that you want to add to your Contact List
- 3. Select Add to Contacts

Outlook Express can be set up to automatically put an address in your Contact List when you Reply to a mail message.

- 1. Under the **Tools** menu, click **Options**
- 2. Click Send
