

Voting in North Dakota

REMEMBER TO UPDATE YOUR ID ADDRESS WHEN YOU MOVE!

Voting absentee or by mail requires a:

- Valid North Dakota ID listed on the flip side of this card
- Passport or military ID – only for ND residents living outside of the U.S. who do not possess one of the other forms of ID
- Attester – An applicant without a valid form of identification may use an attester. The attester must provide his/her name, ND driver's license, non-driver's or tribal ID number and sign the absentee/mail ballot application form to attest to the applicant's ND residency and voting eligibility.

Voting in North Dakota

HAVE YOU UPDATED YOUR ADDRESS WITH YOUR ID PROVIDER FOR VOTING?

Identification for voting in North Dakota must include the voter's:

- Name
- Current residential street address
- Date of birth

Valid forms of ID for voting in-person are a North Dakota:

- Current driver's license or non-driver's identification card
- Tribal government issued identification
- Long-term care certificate (provided by ND facility)
