These limited legal duties are to perform the customary acts typically performed by a Broker in assisting the transaction to the transaction's closing or conclusion with honesty and good faith and to disclose to the customer any adverse material facts actually known by the Broker which pertain to the title of the real property, the physical condition of the real property, and defects in the real property.
A Broker does not owe the agency duties of loyalty, obedience, disclosure, confidentiality, reasonable care diligence, and accounting to a customer. Customers should be aware that any information shared with a Broker may be disclosed. If a Broker represents another party in the same real estate transaction, the Broker is required to place the interest of the represented client first.
You, as a customer, will be responsible to make all decisions pertaining to price and terms of your offer.
