



Duties of the President Elect

All candidates for NDAR positions must meet the following criteria:

- At least three years as an NDAR member and current member
- Licensed as a Broker, salesperson or appraiser
- No license law violation
- Demonstrated leadership in one or more of the following:
 - o prior or current director or officer of a local association
 - o prior or current president of an NDAR affiliated institute or society at the state level
 - o demonstration of participation in NDAR

President Elect Roles & Responsibility:

1. Leadership Preparation and Vision

- Prepare for the transition to the role of President, developing a vision and strategic plan for the upcoming presidential year, working in conjunction with the previous leadership's strategic plans & priorities.
- Participate in meeting preparation as a backup to the President, stepping in to provide details or representation if the President is unavailable.

2. Support and Representation

- Support the President in their leadership duties and assist as needed to ensure continuity.
- Represent NDAR at local, state, regional, and national meetings, including NAR events, and bring back valuable insights to the Executive Committee & Board of Directors.
- o Act as a representative and advocate for NDAR, stepping in as President if required.

3. Executive Leadership and Committee Oversight

- Serve on the Executive Committee for NDAR, contributing to strategic decision-making.
- Director Liaison to Professional Development and Communications Committees, ensuring they align with organizational goals.
- Select and appoint qualified vice chairs for committees and task forces to strengthen leadership and committee operations.
- Act as a Committee Liaison, facilitating communication and collaboration between committees and the Board.

4. Director and Meeting Involvement

 Attend state, regional, and national meetings, including NAR events, to stay informed and engaged in the broader organizational landscape.

National Level:

The President Elect will be requested to attend the NAR Small State Sub-Forum of which the President and AE are automatic members. In addition to this, the President-Elect is requested to apply for a NAR Committee. President-Elect will also be encouraged to attend all National meetings during the term of office – Mid-Year Meetings and Annual Convention; as well as any special called meetings.

<u>Financial Assistance from NDAR:</u> *(amounts are reflective of current budget and are subject to change each year)

- Mid-year Meetings in Washington, DC in May as budgeted
- Expenses for NAR Leadership Meetings in Chicago in August as budgeted
- National Convention in November as budgeted
- NDAR Board of Directors meetings held in a location other than your own Local Board as budgeted.
- REALTOR® Convention of the Dakotas as budgeted
- Expenses for Region 8 Meeting

*Expense Policy:

Any National travel expenses for the President-Elect are allocated in detail in the annual budget of NDAR. The amounts may vary each year. Accounting for expenses must be submitted on a prescribed form available from staff. A written report must be submitted to NDAR within 30 days of travel.
