NDAR NAR Director Positions



Starting in 2023 each state association will have a NAR Director from a small board (1-499) and a medium board (500-1,999).

By online application the applicant will mostly self-certify that they meet the requirements and qualifications.

Interviews will be conducted by NDAR Nominating TF after July 31 deadline for NAR to verify local board membership numbers. Interviews for those submissions will be held on Thursday, August 18 starting at 10:00 am (CST) throughout the morning depending on the number of applicants.

*Application Deadline to NAR: <u>Wednesday, August 13, 2025</u>
*Interviews (after July 30) to be held by Nominating Taskforce and name forwarded to NDAR Board of Directors for appointment. Interviews to be held on August 18, 2025, in the morning by Zoom.
NDAR Submits name to NAR by NO later than September 15, 2025.

The Board of Directors is the legislative and decision-making body which acts on behalf of members to govern activities of the National Association of REALTORS[®]. This is an important and solemn responsibility because decisions of the Board of Directors in large measure and determine the present and future course of our Association and the services available to over 1.6 million members.

Participate in two NAR Meetings: November-NAR Conference, and April/May-Legislative Meeting, Washington, DC

In addition to the responsibilities of the NAR Board of Directors, the NAR Directors also act as liaison between the State and National Association by keeping the State Association informed of the activities of the National Association and by presenting to the National Association Board of Directors any programs or suggestions of the State Association.

National Directors shall endeavor to attend all State Association and Board Meetings and report regularly to the State Association President and at all in-state Board of Director meetings.

Article V of NDAR Bylaws specifically designates all North Dakota National Directors as full voting members of the North Dakota Association of REALTORS[®] Board of Directors.

NAR COMMITTEES:

NAR Directors are requested to apply for at least one NAR committee (with discussion with NDAR Staff Leadership).

FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE FROM NDAR: (amounts are reflective of current budget and may change each year)

- NDAR Board of Directors meetings held in a location other than your own Local Board.

***EXPENSE POLICY:**

Any national travel expenses are allocated in detail each year in the NDAR budget. The amount may vary each year. Accounting for expenses must be submitted on a prescribed form available from staff. A written report must be submitted to NDAR within 30 days of travel.
