## Legislative & Political Advocacy

Lobbying – NDAR represents your interest at the State Capital in Bismarck. Our Association Executive, also NDAR's chief lobbyist, is present when the legislature is in session and fights for the issues that affect you. REALTOR® members often testify on issues of importance to the Association. Our Political Affairs Committee meets several times prior to the start of each session to set the legislative agenda for NDAR.

RPAC – REALTORS® Political Action Committee – ND RPAC works to elect candidates who think like you do, who understand your needs as a small business owner and real estate professional. RPAC effectiveness depends on your support. Help us to ensure a legislature that understands you completely. Make your fair share investment today.

Issues Mobilization Committee – The Issues Mobilization Committee works to support grassroots lobbying and educational efforts related to state and local issues that impact real property in North Dakota. The Committee seeks to improve public policy by encouraging and stimulating REALTORS® to take a more active part in the governmental process.

Legislative Impact Day – The day is a bi-annual event when North Dakota REALTORS® convene in Bismarck to visit the State Capitol and meet with legislators to discuss current real estate issues affecting your business. Capped off with the Legendary Chili/Oyster Stew Feed held in honor of the state elected officials.

Capitol Hill Visits – An annual visit to Washington, D.C., by a delegation of ND REALTORS® to meet with our U.S. Congressman and Senators to discuss federal issues involving real estate and property rights.

Legislative Weekly Updates – Each Friday during the ND Legislative session, a report is generated listing all the bills NDAR is following. The report is posted on the website [www.NDRealtors.com](http://www.NDRealtors.com) and a briefing is held at noon at the NDAR office building. Each local board is invited to call in on a conference call to offer input and get up to date information on the session.
